article V. MEMBERSHIP Section 2. Candidacy

A. Any person in agreement with the principles described in this Constitution and By-Laws may offer one's self as a candidate for membership in this church. All such candidates will be presented to the church at any regular worship service for membership in any of the following ways:

(1) Profession of faith and baptism according to the policies of the church.

(2) Promise of a letter from another Baptist Church of like faith and order.

(3) Statement of faith and that he has been baptized by immersion in a church of like faith.

B. Members will be accepted by majority vote of those present and voting.

C. The candidate will be expected to maintain the principles of this document throughout their membership.

Definition

Tithe = First 10% of one's income given back to God to further Christ's command of the Great Commission.

Offering = anything given over the Tithe, may be used to support individual needs.
